## After Dinner Program

“The Three – Year Restoration of the Yavapai  
County Courthouse”

Speaker — Bill Otwell

Learn about the restoration of the Courthouse we love. Bill will overview Prescott’s historic buildings and then discuss the restoration of our Courthouse, illustrated with construction photos of the building and the stone quarry where the granite came from, plus many more images of all the major restoration work and energy upgrades involved in the process. Bill graduated from ASU in 1973 with a Bachelor of Architecture degree. In 2016, he was elevated to a Fellow, American Institute of Architects (FAIA), for his contributions to American Architecture (only 3% of American Architects are Fellows). His historical restorations include the Elks Theatre, the Hassayampa Hotel and the Palace Bar.
