“Zane Grey in Northern Arizona”

Presenter: Harvey Leake

Zane Grey, the highly successful author of western novels, gained much of his inspiration from his many trips to northern Arizona from 1906 through 1929. The landscapes and personalities he encountered provided him with compelling background material that he used to add realism to his fictional narratives.

Harvey Leake is an authority on the history of his pioneering ancestors, the Wetherills of the Four Corners region. His research has taken him to libraries, archives, homes of family elders, remote trading posts and some routes used by his great-grandfather, John Wetherill, to access the intricate canyon country of the Colorado Plateau. Harvey was born and raised in Prescott and is a retired electrical engineer.
