“John Riley and the San Patricios: Facts Versus Folklore”

Presenter: Ray Herbeck

Although it sounds like fiction, John Riley, a former Private of the Fifth U.S. Infantry, did form a battalion to fight against the U.S. in the Mexican War of 1846-'48. His unit, called the San Patricios, was comprised of deserters or defected captives of the U.S. Army. Learn about this seldom mentioned event in American history.

Prescott resident, Ray Herbeck, is a 20-year veteran writer, producer and technical advisor of historical films and documentaries. He was the Associate Producer for the triple Academy Award-winning movie “Glory”. Ray is a director of Prescott’s Western Heritage Foundation and member of the Western Writers of America.
