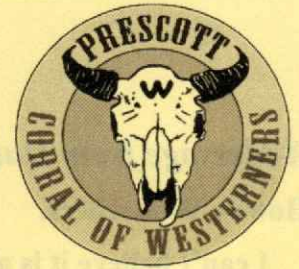

"How Prescott Got Its Name"

Presenter: Phil Goode

This presentation is a historical justification of the connection of the founding of Prescott, Arizona with the beginnings of the Revolutionary War and why Prescott is pronounced "Preskitt" and not "Prescott".

Former Prescott City Council Mayor Phil Goode served a combat tour with the 101st Airborne Division in Vietnam where he was highly decorated for his actions in over 60 helicopter combat assaults. He then had a 35-year career in the healthcare industry where he held several upper management and Vice President positions. Phil was elected to the Prescott City Council in 2026 and was first elected Mayor of Prescott in 2021 and reelected in 2023. He has a deep interest in American history and is a member of the Prescott Chapter of the Sons of the American Revolution.

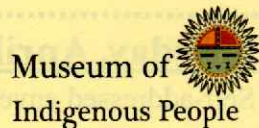
