“The Chiricahua Apaches: A Concise History”

Presenter: Bill Cavaliere

This is the overview of the fascinating history of the Chiricahua Apaches, covering their arrival in the American southwest, their culture, early conflicts with the White people, major battles and peace treaties, the controversial use of Apache scouts in the Army, famous Chiricahua chiefs, their surrender, and where the Chiricahua Apaches are today. Their story is one of perseverance and tenacity, of courage and sorrow, and triumph and tragedy.

Bill Cavaliere retired after 28 years in law enforcement, during which time he was sheriff of Hidalgo County, N.M. Prior to this he was employed by the U.S. Forest Service in the Chiricahua Mountains. He is currently president of the Cochise County Historical Society and has written articles for numerous historical publications.

### *A Message from Our Sheriff*

Greetings Prescott Corral Members,

Both Bill and his wife, Jill, will be traveling here from their ranch near Portal, AZ located not too far from the Chiricahua National Monument. His soft cover book on the Chiricahua Apaches will be available for \$20. Please bring cash. Let's give them a warm Westerners welcome.

At this mid-point in our year, we still have a need for a member in good standing to fill our Deputy Sheriff's position. This is a most important role as that person will become the Sheriff in 2027.
