Presenter: Linda Hayes

Our very own Westerners member Linda Hayes will talk about the history of women in rodeo from the 1800's to the present day. The focus of her presentation will be how women's rodeo events have changed over the decades. Linda will be speaking from her personal experience of traveling the country competing in rodeos as a professional barrel racer for over 40 years. During her time on the rodeo circuit, she won 5 barrel racing championships and was a runner-up to Miss Rodeo USA. Outside of the arena, she spent 20 years teaching school in Texas and had one of the first llama ranches in the country.
